In order to attend our five (5) day Train the Trainer (TTT) program, and become a certified Verbal Judo in house Instructor, one must first be sponsored by his/her agency. At the inception of the 5 day program, the attendee will sign a waiver (a legal and binding document) indicating their understanding and agreement with the stipulation that after successful completion of the program, the attendee will be certified to teach the basic Verbal Judo program only to members of the agency/institution with which they are currently employed. If they separate from their sponsoring agency, their certification will be invalid until such time as the certified trainer finds employment with another Law Enforcement Agency. The certification is valid for 3 years, after which time attendee must attend our re-certification program if they wish to remain certified.
